Poster Contest Rules Bonita Springs Arbor Day Festival

April 25, 2020 (10 a.m. to 1 p.m.) at the Bonita Springs YMCA

1. **Eligibility:** All students in grades K-8 are eligible to enter their schools' poster contest.
2. **Email Submission:** Please email one image per poster to Jack Brown (jackdbrown@gmail.com) by 5:30pm on April 22nd. If submitted via email, each school may submit five (5) posters per grade. We will display them on 8.5" x 11" paper.

Physical Submission: If your school would like to host a table and would like to display the posters (or other information on your school), you may bring them with you during the set-up process for the festival. Posters may be on poster or drawing paper, flat, not be folded or rolled. Posters cannot be smaller than 8.5" x 11" and no larger than 22" x 28" (standard poster board). Please let us know in advance so we can arrange a table.

3. **Originality:** Posters must be original. Copyrighted images are not acceptable.
4. **Medium:** Posters may be drawn in marker, crayon, colored pencil, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic, tempera paint, or original works of digital art. Bright colors that reproduce well are best.
5. **Theme:** Include the theme, "**Bonita Trees**" in the poster design.
6. **Signatures:** For each image submitted by email, please include the student's full name, grade, and school (or organization). Otherwise, provide this information clearly on the back of the poster.
7. **Judging Criteria:** Members of the Bonita Springs Tree Advisory Board will select the winning posters based on creativity and connection to the theme. Judges will select three winners per school/organization.
