

Lee County Shelters Remain Open

BONITA SPRINGS, Fla. – October 9th, 2024– The Lee County Emergency Operations Center issued mandatory evacuations for Zone A and Zone B on Monday. Please visit the Lee County Emergency Operations webpage to find your evacuation zone or [click here](#). People who live in mobile homes and manufactured homes are also part of the evacuation order. All shelters are pet-friendly; pets must be on leashes or in kennels. Lee County has opened shelters in advance of the approach of Hurricane Milton.

Lee County has 13 shelters open for those evacuating from Hurricane Milton. All shelters have capacity to welcome more evacuees. There is still time to leave and get to safety, but that window is closing as severe weather is expected to move into our area this afternoon/evening.
